

Treatment for Worms in Dogs and Cats

What sort of animal do you have? (cat or dog?).
How many cats and dogs do you have altogether?

IF DOGS ↓

What breed of dog do you have?

Do you know the weight of your dog in kgs/lbs?

(Refer to chart as a guide - Remember this is only a rough guide)

Does your dog take tablets easily?

Yes – suggest Drontal Plus for Dogs – see below for dosage recommendations.

No – suggest Panacur Granules which can easily be added to food – (Refer to pack for dosage recommendations.)

DOSAGE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DRONTAL PLUS FOR DOGS

Bodyweight (kg/lbs)	Recommended Dose
Puppies & Small Dogs	
2 – 5 kg (4 – 11lb)	1/2 tablet
6 – 10 kg (13 – 22lb)	1 tablet
Medium Dogs	
11 – 15kg (24 – 33lb)	1 1/2 tablets
16 – 20kg (35 – 44lb)	2 tablets
21 – 25kg (46 – 55lb)	2 1/2 tablets
26 – 30kg (57 – 66lb)	3 tablets
Large Dogs	
31 – 35kg (68 – 77lb)	3 1/2 tablets
36 – 40kg (79 – 88lb)	4 tablets

How old is your dog?

Puppies can be treated with Drontal Plus from 2 weeks of age and every 2 weeks until 12 weeks of age. Thereafter they should be treated at 3 monthly intervals. It is advisable to treat the bitch at the same time as the puppies. Consult a vet before treating pregnant animals.

IF CATS ↓

What size cat do you have?

(An average cat weighs about 4kgs or 9lbs – Refer to chart as a guide - Remember this is only a rough guide)

Does your cat take tablets easily?

Yes – suggest Drontal Tablets for Cats can be given direct or in food – see below for dosage recommendations.

No – suggest Panacur Granules which can easily be added to food. (Refer to pack for dosage recommendations.)

DOSAGE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DRONTAL PLUS FOR CATS

Bodyweight (kg/lbs)	Recommended Dose
Puppies & Small Dogs	
Up to 2kg (4lb)	1/2 tablet
4kg (9lb)	1 tablet
6kg (13lb)	1 1/2 tablets

How old is your cat?

Drontal Tablets for Cats are not intended for use in kittens less than 6 weeks of age and should not be used during pregnancy.

Adult cats and dogs should be treated against worms every 12 weeks.
